
Reflection

The Good News we announce as disciples does have its cost.

This Sunday's gospel opens with the statement that John the Baptist "had been arrested." This statement not only foreshadows the fate of Jesus but it also reveals one important aspect of discipleship: we too will have to take up the cross. Discipleship means that we follow Jesus to the cross by willingly dying to ourselves for the good of others. Strange, this "good" news that leads us to a cross! What is so "good" about that? On our own, we would quickly get discouraged and lose our way. But in Christ, we are never alone. Our Christian faith tells us that when we hear and respond to Jesus' call to follow, to come to the cross, we do not walk alone, Jesus has announced the time of fulfillment, that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He calls us to participate in announcing the Good news of the Kingdom. And so WE walk with Jesus. We walk with him to the cross; we also walk with him into resurrection – and THAT is the Good News!

Archbishop Thomas Collins

On January 6, 2012, the Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, announced that His Grace will be elevated to the College of Cardinals. On behalf of all parishioners, Fr. John sent a note of congratulations to the Archbishop. The formal consistory, at which the new cardinals will be created, will take place February 18-19 in Rome. Cardinal-designate Collins will become the fourth cardinal in the 110-year history of the Archdiocese of Toronto and the 16th cardinal in the history of the Roman Catholic Church in Canada.

For your information; the Archdiocese of Toronto is Canada's largest diocese, stretching from Toronto north to Georgian Bay and from Oshawa to Mississauga. It is home to 1.9 million Catholics and 225 churches, with Mass celebrated in more than 30 different languages each week.
