Preface

"Many Christians were recently shocked when the published letters of Mother Teresa of Calcutta revealed that she lived for years without any direct experience of God's presence. But she was sustained by her belief that Jesus wanted her to do the work she was doing. So she decided to do it as she thought Jesus would have done it. She was consoled when her spiritual director reminded her that Jesus' presence is a gift and is not always seen or heard or even "felt" but is something that we must believe.

Her experience is also like what most of us experience, especially regarding the real presence of Christ in the Eucharistic bread and wine. We believe that Christ is present, but we do not have any sense experience to confirm our belief. The belief in God's real presence---God's choice to be with us and save us--- is the foundation of our human existence, the message of the Bible and the content of our most fundamental Christian beliefs like the Trinity and the Incarnation. So let us explore the meaning of our belief in God's real Presence by understanding its scriptural foundation, its doctrinal explanation and its relation to the Eucharist that we celebrate each week."


