

Collecting our Prayers

"All these were constantly devoting themselves to prayer, together with certain women, including Mary, the Mother of Jesus, as well as his brothers." (Acts 1:14)

Reflection: As the opening part of the Mass concludes, the priest announces: "Let us pray." After a moment of silence, he says a prayer called the "Collect", an appropriate name for this brief statement in which the Church gathers up, collects, all the desires and needs in our hearts and gives voice to them, directing them to God the Father, through Christ, in the Holy Spirit. We bring to Mass our own joys and sorrows, hopes and sufferings. As representatives of the world around us we also bring the needs of humanity. The opening rite of the Mass, in which we re-establish our unity, concludes with our recalling God's past goodness, offering thanks, and asking for further gifts.

Experience of Life: For years Noreen H. and her husband had been facing a challenging economic situation. When the bank began to hound them about repaying a loan, she found herself accusing her husband of mismanaging their finances. The needs of their four children along with day-to-day expenses, foreseen and unforeseen, were testing their faith. Even her end-of-year bonus made only a small dent in their mounting debt. One day when a loan payment was due, she prayed at Mass for a stronger faith in God, and in God's love. Later that day she heard a knock on the door. It was the letter-carrier with a special delivery envelope. Upon opening it she found a large payment for a job her husband had done the previous summer. She could hardly believe it! God intervenes! Their economic problems are still not fully resolved, but she and her husband have learned that they have to remain firmly rooted in God, believe confidently in Providence, and above all maintain unity between them.
