Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are held on the 4th Sunday of every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

February 19, 2017

"Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect"



If someone insults you or tries to take advantage of you, how do you respond? Do you repay in kind? Jesus approached the question of just retribution with a surprising revelation of God's intention for how we should treat others, especially those who mistreat us. When Jesus spoke about God's law, he did something no one had done before. He gave a new standard based not just on the requirements of justice - giving each their due – but based on the law of grace and love. Jesus knew the law and it's intentions better than any jurist or legal expert could imagine. He quoted from the oldest recorded law in the world: *If any harm follows, then you shall give life for life, eye for eye,*

tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, burn for burn, wound for wound, stripe for stripe (Exodus 21:23-25). Such a law today seems cruel, but it was meant to limit vengeance as a first step towards mercy. This law was not normally taken literally but served as a guide for a judge in court for assessing punishment and penalty (see Deuteronomy 19:18). Jesus does something quite remarkable. He transforms the law of mercy with grace and loving kindness. Jesus also makes clear that there is no room for retaliation. We must not only avoid returning evil for evil, but we must seek the good of those who wish us ill.

What makes Christians different from others and what makes Christianity distinct from any other religion? It is <code>grace</code> – treating others, not as they deserve, but as God wishes them to be treated – with loving kindness and mercy. Our love for others, even those who are ungrateful and selfish towards us, must be marked by the same kindness and mercy which God has shown to us. It is easier to show kindness and mercy when we can expect to benefit from doing so. How much harder is it when we can expect nothing in return. Our prayer for those who do us ill both breaks the power of revenge and releases the power of love to do good in the face of evil. How can we possibly love those who cause us harm or ill-will? With God all things are possible. He gives power and grace to those who believe and accept the gift of the Holy Spirit. His love conquers all, even our hurts, fears, prejudices and grief. Only the cross of Jesus Christ can free us from the tyranny of malice, hatred, revenge and resentment and gives us the courage to return evil with good.

Was Jesus exaggerating when he said we must be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect? The original meaning of "perfect" in Aramaic is "completeness" or "wholeness" - not lacking in what is essential. God gives us every good gift in Jesus Christ so that we may not lack anything we need to do His will and to live as sons and daughters (2 Peter 1:3). He knows our weakness and sinfulness better than we do. And he assures us of his love, mercy and grace to follow in his ways. Do you want to grow in your love for God and for your neighbour? Ask the Holy Spirit to change and transform you in the image of the Father that you may walk in the joy and freedom.

COUNTDOWN TO LENT

On March the first we begin the Holy Season of Lent. Ash Wednesday formally inaugurates this holy season of spiritual growth as we receive ashes on our foreheads and hear the words "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel". I invite you to heed the Lord's words during Lent: "Return to me with all your heart". One of the highlights of our Lenten season here at St. Francis of Assisi will be the Mission preached by Fr. Fred Mazzarella, OFM. Please mark your calendars (March 11-15) and stay tuned for more details. May this Lent be a time of spiritual growth for all of us so that, with hearts renewed, we may celebrate Easter with great joy.
