#### Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are held on the 4th Sunday of every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

#### Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

#### Sacrament of the Sick

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. For your spiritual needs during a hospital stay, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned a full time Roman Catholic Chaplain to each of the two Mississauga hospitals. For the Chaplain, speak to the Nurses' Desk or call the Spiritual Care Office.

# Pope Francis – Mercy from the Manger – Reflections for Advent LIVING IN THE LIGHT

Through the course of history, light that shatters the darkness reveals to us that God is Father and that his patient fidelity is stronger than darkness and corruption.

(Homily, December 24, 2014)

Lord, I become so stressed at this time of year. Despite my most earnest plans to spend some quiet time thanking you for the most tangible sign of your mercy - the coming of your Son - I find myself behaving in anything but a merciful manner. I get so concerned about gifts and gatherings that I become cranky with my family, friends, coworkers and even strangers on the Help me put aside the street. personal darkness that busyness can create and focus on your light. Help me to rest in your arms, today and always. Amen

In prayer our hearts find the strength not to be cold and insensitive in the face of situations of injustice. In prayer, God keeps calling us, opening our hearts to charity.

(Visit to the Charitable Center of St. Patrick Parish and Meeting with the Homeless, September 24, 2015)

Lord, I sometimes find myself numb to the challenges of the world. They seem overwhelming. I ask "What can I, as one person, do to actually change anything? What does my visit to the sick or the imprisoned, or my donation to the food pantry or homeless shelter, accomplish? Lord, I pray that you keep my heart and head open to offering charity to others. Be my eyes and light the light of compassion in my soul, no matter how small my service seems to me at times. May I delight in the way you use me. Amen.

Chosen to be the Mother of the Son of God, Mary, from the outset, was prepared by the love of God to be the 'Ark of the Covenant' between God and man. She treasured divine mercy in her heart in perfect harmony with her Son Jesus. (Misericordiae Vultus)

Lord, I am in awe of the Blessed Mother's faith in you and your plan, from the moment of the Annunciation to the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. While she pondered in her heart over the unusual events of her life, she never ceased to give you praise. May I be willing to embrace your plan for me. May I remember that your way is always best, even when your reasoning is beyond my human power to understand. May I surrender my will as gracefully as Mary did and walk in the light. Amen.

O God, by whose word all things are sanctified, pour forth your blessing upon this wreath and grant that we who use it may prepare our hearts for the Coming of Christ, and may receive from you abundant graces. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Prayer: O Emmanuel, Jesus Christ, desire of every nation, Saviour of all peoples, come and dwell among us. Amen.

In order to register for Confirmation, please bring the following with you to the meeting:

- 1. PHOTOCOPY OF THE CANDIDATE'S CATHOLIC BAPTISM CERTIFICATE
- 2. \$20 for the Confirmation resource fee
- 3. The name of your Confirmation Sponsor. A Confirmation Sponsor must fulfill the following conditions:
  - a. Confirmed Catholic
  - b. 16 years of age or older
  - c. Practising Catholic
  - d. Not be the parent of the Candidate

Each meeting will be held in St. Francis of Assisi Church Hall (Basement).

These are the only 2 registration sessions being held for Confirmation in January 2017. If you miss these sessions, you are most welcome to register for Confirmation in 2018.


