Sacrament of Baptism

The desire for Baptism for a child must be accompanied by a very serious commitment to raise the child within the Catholic faith community and to educate the child in the truths of the church. An essential part of the commitment is regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Baptisms are held on the 4th Sunday of every month. Please contact the parish office for a Baptismal package.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to be married should contact the parish one year in advance. They must also attend a Marriage Preparation Course prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil divorce or religious marriage with another person, please notify the priest as soon as possible as the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's Office has been contacted.

In this Sacrament we celebrate Christ's healing presence among us today. If you, a relative or friend, require this Sacrament at home or nursing home, please call the parish office. For your spiritual needs during a hospital stay, the Archdiocese of Toronto has assigned a full time Roman Catholic Chaplain to each of the two Mississauga hospitals. THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

November 5, 2017

"All who exalt themselves will be humbled, and all who humble themselves will be exalted."

Jesus denounced the hypocritical behaviour of the scribes and Pharisees, who were teachers of the Mosaic Law. Their job was to interpret the law which made them influential in determining Jewish practices. Both Jesus and the scribes and Pharisees used Mosaic Law but Jesus' interpretations often differed.

Although he acknowledged that their teaching authority rested on the "chair of Moses" (the "chair of Peter" is a similar term for church authority), he warned his disciples not to follow their example. These religious leaders enjoyed their titles of honour and liked to call attention to their "phylacteries" as evidence of their piety. The tassels sewn on the hem of a man's garment were a symbolic reminder to keep the Law of Moses. While religious leaders demanded obedience in the minute details of the Law, their own deeds did not always correspond to their words. They were prone to interpreting the law so that their observances gave them an elite status. They did not always practice what they preached. In contrast, Jesus was a humble servant and teacher of God's Law by his practice of love and mercy.

"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus" (**Philippians 2:3-5**).




