Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

## DOCTRINAL CORNER

### When should a child start going to Reconciliation (Confession)?

In consultation with the pastor, a child normally starts going to Confession as he/she prepares for First Holy Communion and after he/she has received instruction (catechesis) on this sacrament from the parish.

### Is it the school’s responsibility to prepare the children for this Sacrament?

No, the preparation for this Sacrament is the parish’s responsibility. However, children often receive instruction in our Catholic schools.



### Celebration of Marriage Mass

As part of Marriage Sunday 2023 celebrations, Bishop Nguyen will preside at a special Mass to honour married couples, especially those celebrating milestone wedding anniversaries (25th, 40th, 50th, 60th or 60+) in 2023. The Mass will take place at **2:30 p.m. on Sunday, February 12, 2023 at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica** (65 Bond Street, Toronto). All married couples will have an opportunity to renew their vows and milestone anniversary celebrants will be honoured with a special blessing.
