Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Parents of the child to be baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.

Clergy may serve as godparents (sponsors) but are asked not be the minister of baptism if serving as a godparent (sponsor) so that the roles are not confused.



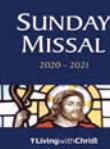
