DOCTRINAL CORNER

Are we allowed to keep the cremated remains of our loved ones at home?

No, we are not. Cremated remains should be treated with the same respect given to the corporeal remains of the human body. While cremated remains may be buried in a grave, entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium, the practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.
