Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Why were the descendants of Adam and Eve punished for their sins?

Let's answer this with an analogy. Suppose your grandfather inherited great wealth which he himself had not earned. Unfortunately, because he was addicted to gambling he lost all of it. You, as a grandson, would have inherited great wealth but instead got nothing. This is the case with original sin. Adam and Eve were given a precious gift they did not earn but they lost it and so their descendants did not inherit it. But God is so good because He offers us not just the exalted state in which Adam and Eve were created, but a much higher state of union with Him through Christ. What we have to do is to accept the offer (initially through Baptism).
