



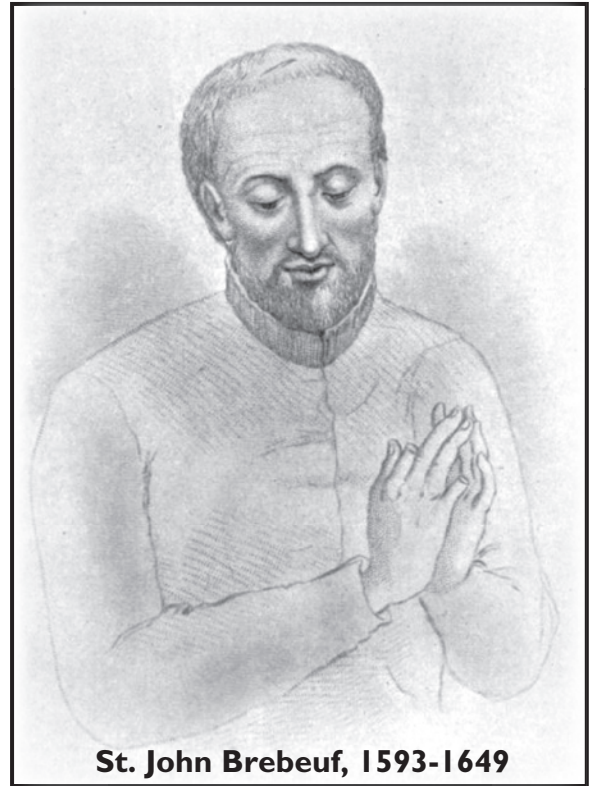

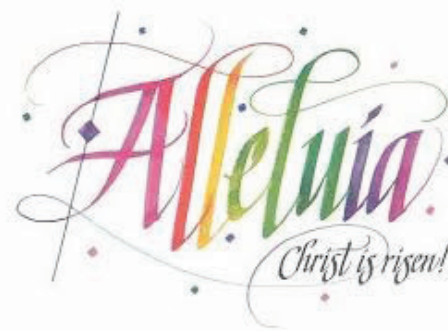
**Funerals:** Please speak to Fr. Wayne **before** meeting with the Funeral Home.
