From Father Mark: In the 14th Century hymn that is ours under the title "Jesus Christ is Ris'n Today" the words draw us to the understanding that it is our day of triumph, our day of holiness, our day of victory and our day of understanding that these past days of Triduum lead us with one word:

Alleluia... That's all we can say to describe what we have done, where we have been and how much God truly loves us.

With this in mind, the words Thank You seem almost to be insignificant in how I would like to describe what is in my heart over these days (and months) that we have been together. I had to go through a period of mourning letting St. Paul the Apostle Parish go. It was a remarkable six years, of growth, of joy, of all the many things that make us as we are. You were patient in accepting me, and letting me, in my own time, say so long to them. In all of that, you were kind, welcoming, gentle, loving and very forgiving. 

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Ps 118.2-4, 13-15, 22-24 R. Give thanks for the Lord is good. God's love is everlasting.




