



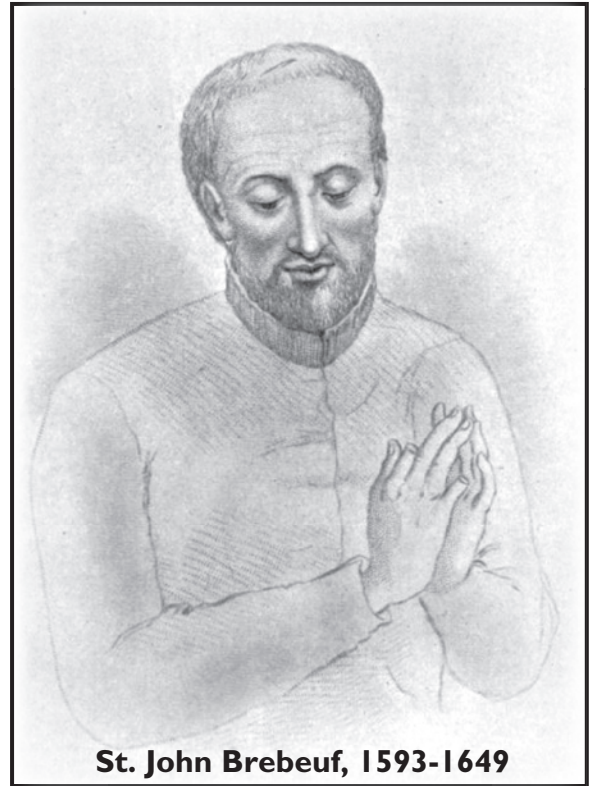

Updated Restrictions for In-Person Masses:

Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 15 minutes prior to Masses.

As of April 20, maximum capacity for faith-based gatherings has been reduced to **50 people**. **Reservations are once again required through the Parish Office**, and will be accepted weekdays until Friday at 1pm, or until capacity is reached (whichever occurs first).

Celebration of Weddings, Funerals, and Baptisms are now limited to ten (10) people.

The Parish Office remains closed to the public until further notice. All emails and phone messages will be returned as soon as possible.

Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sign in with your name and phone number (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.
