From Archbishop Gagnon:

This past Wednesday, we gathered in our parishes to pray for the people of France due to the destruction of Notre Dame de Paris. At the same time we cannot forget about the human tragedy that has occurred in Sri Lanka due to the terrorist bombings on Easter Sunday with over 300 people killed and 500 injured. The loss of Notre Dame is the loss of a great symbol of faith that has given many people a sense of hope during times of tragedy over the past almost 900 years, including two world wars. Yet a building is not equal to the value of human beings even though hope is essential to us. Sri Lanka, in a tragic way, reminds us that Good Friday preceded the Resurrection of Christ and that it is faith in Christ's abiding presence which sustains us in our suffering.

On May 12, 2019 we are celebrating 4th Sunday of Easter (Good Shepherd Sunday) – the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.
