

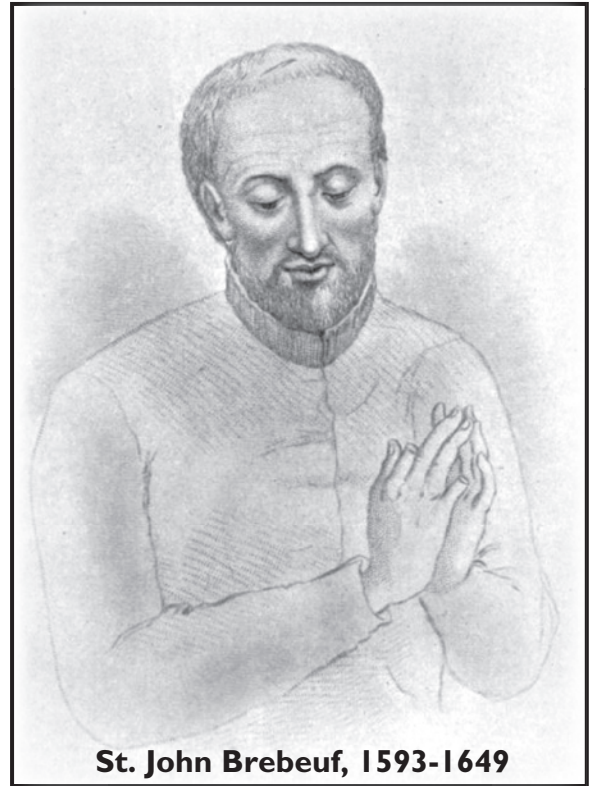

**Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Benediction:** Every Friday at 8:15am.

## RECYCLE YOUR BATTERIES

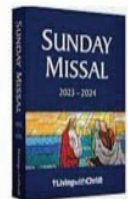


You can now find a dedicated box at the main entrance of SJB Parish where you can drop off your used batteries for proper recycling.
