

Donation Drive for Refugee Families in Winnipeg:

While our parish and St. Paul the Apostle are still waiting to be matched with a refugee family to sponsor, we have heard about some of the needs of families who are already settling in Winnipeg. Two families have come to our attention because they both have many young children who could benefit from some extra care beyond what is typically provided through a sponsorship. One family has 7 children-4 are teenagers in high school and they need a desk and a refurbished computer to do their homework. The second family has 6 children, all under the age of 8 years old, and their mom is expecting twins! They will need a double stroller, two cribs or bassinettes, diapers, wipes, and a change table. Both families need clothes for their children, a sturdy wagon to carry food home, toys for the children, school supplies, and basic kitchen supplies like mixing bowls and utensils.

There is a full list for each family on the front page of the parish website (www.sjbcommunity.ca). As you sign up to provide an item, it gets crossed of the list automatically. Please use the sign up so that way we won't end up with doubles of anything. Starting April 9th, new or gently used items can be dropped off before or after any of the weekend masses in Fr. Mark's garage behind the parish office. If you have any trouble signing up, call or stop by the parish office during the week and we can help you with the sign up.
