

Catholic Women's League: Information will be shared through emails and calls.



In-Person Masses Have Resumed in the Church: Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 15 minutes prior to

Masses.

Current maximum capacity is 100 people. With the exception of Easter weekend, reservations will no longer be required.

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sign in with your name and phone number (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church.

Please sanitize your hands as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please leave your offering in the designated basket at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please exit as soon as Mass ends without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

The Parish Office closes at Noon Holy Thursday, and reopens Tuesday at 8:30. (We remain closed to the public.) Messages will be returned on Tues., April 6.


