Our Place/Chez Nous is drop-in centre that serves our city's homeless, mentally ill and marginalized in the Main and Higgins area. The centre provides those in need with a time of respite and fellowship from life on the street, as well as clothing, footwear, toiletries and food. Current needs include:



- Dark coloured hoodies, Men's Jeans, Toilet Paper
- Non-perishable food items such as canned soups, stews, baked beans, Kraft dinner, tuna, etc.
- Dark-coloured winter jackets and warm winter boots

Although the centre closes for the summer, donations are always accepted at the main church entrance.

Maison Ste. Marie was established by the Sisters of Charity of Montreal, "Grey Nuns", in 1869. The arrangement with the Grey Nuns was temporary and in 1874 the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary (SNJM) assumed responsibility of St. Mary's Academy. On August 22, 1874, four SNJM arrived in Winnipeg and on September 1, 1874 the Sisters registered their first students—12 boys and 7 girls. To date over 62,000 students have graduated from the Academy. From the humblest of beginnings, to its 150th Birthday in 2019, the SNJM have remained devoted to their Mission, "to seek the full development of the human person through education, social justice, contemplation and the arts, especially with people who are impoverished and marginalized."

Join the Academy at the Gala as we pay tribute to the SNJM for their unwavering commitment to learning, faith, service and leadership.



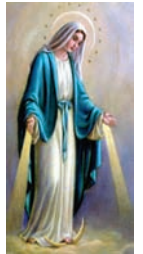
