

Our Place/Chez Nous: Our Place/Chez Nous is drop-in centre that



serves our city's homeless, mentally ill and marginalized in the Main and Higgins area. The centre provides those in need with a time of respite and fellowship from life on the street, as well as clothing, footwear, toiletries and food. Current needs include:

- Dark coloured hoodies, Men's Jeans, Toilet Paper
- Non-perishable food items such as canned soups, stews, baked beans, Kraft dinner, tuna, etc.
- Dark-coloured winter jackets and warm winter boots

Although the centre closes for the summer, donations are always accepted at the main church entrance.
