

More than 5,000 Canadian Youth made their way to Lisbon, Portugal to be with Pope Francis, from 1 to 6 August 2023. The Holy Father joined more than one million young people for World Youth Day (WYD), an international gathering of youth, organized by the Catholic Church. The first international World Youth Day was held in 1986, and the event was hosted by Canada in 2002, with Pope Saint John Paul II making the pilgrimage to Toronto.

The Pope's prayer intention for this month is for the WYD. We pray the World Youth Day in Lisbon will help young people to live and witness the Gospel in their own lives.
