

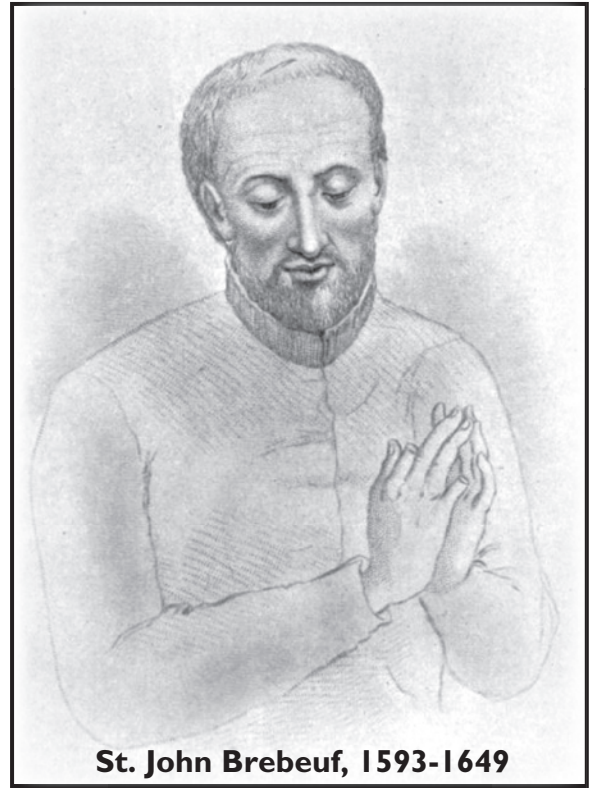

Donations are accepted in the main church entrance bin.

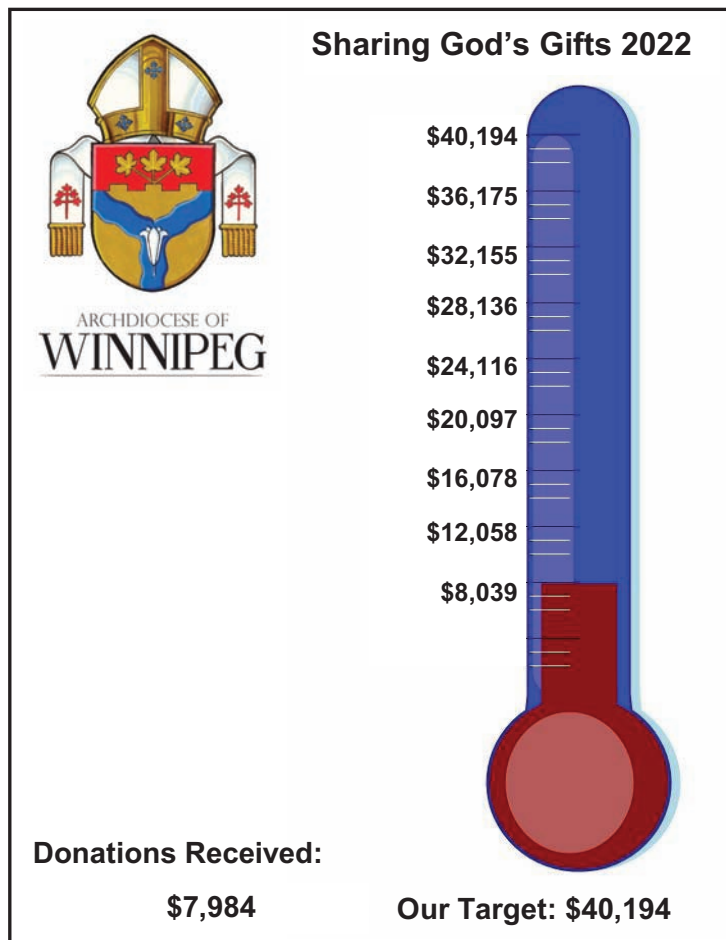
