



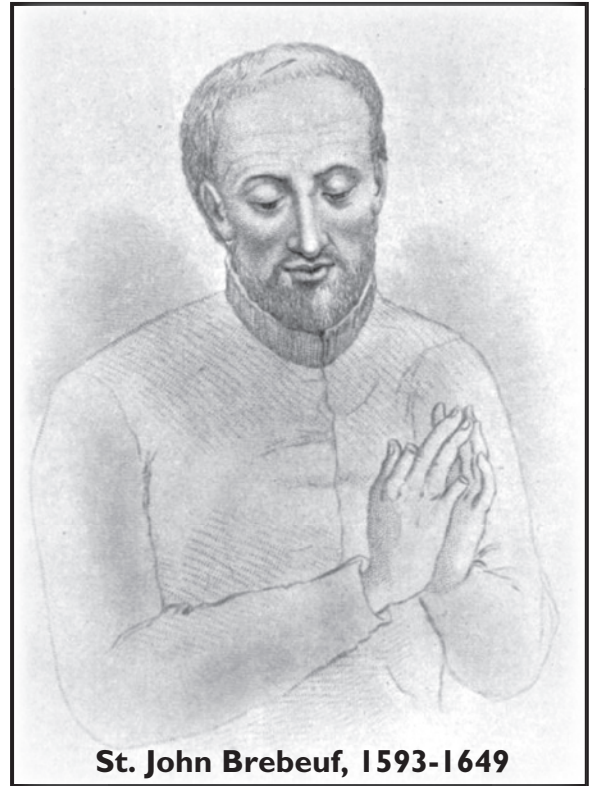

While we continue to face the challenges of Masses at limited capacity, we wish to express our heartfelt thanks to all who have donated to the parish during the pandemic.

As the costs of running the parish continue during a time when our attendance is limited and so many are away for the summer months, we ask that you consider sharing your gifts through one of our convenient **pre-authorized giving options**. Masses continue in the School Gym:

Although we were hoping to resume Masses in the church by now, there was a two week delay in flooring installation. After a period of quarantine, installers are now back at work and it is our hope to resume Masses in our worship space later this month. As summer bulletins are only published bi-weekly, please continue to visit the parish website for updates.

Until further notice, then, Masses will continue in the School Gym. Entry will be via the 605 Renfrew St. door only, which opens 15 minutes prior to Masses. *(*Subject to change when construction complete)*

We continue to limit capacity to 50 people.

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Weekday Masses: Attendees are required to sign in upon entry, including name and phone number. No reservations are required for weekday Masses. Please note that there is no Morning Prayer or Rosary at this time.

Weekend Masses: To attend Saturday 5pm and Sunday 10am Masses, reservations are required through the Parish Office. **Email Claudia at cmoreta@sjbcommunity.ca or call 204-488-4467 (Ext. 217)** to submit your request, leaving your name, phone number, and the names of those in your family who wish to attend. You will be contacted before the weekend to confirm availability. Multiple weekend requests will not be accepted, as we try to give as many people as possible the opportunity to attend Mass. Those wishing to try in person on the weekend for a walk-up spot may do so, understanding that we cannot exceed the 50 person capacity in this limited space. Please see the Knights of Columbus greeter to check off your name(s) or inquire about availability upon arrival at Mass.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** when you enter for Mass.

For Masses in the gym, seating is spaced in six foot (2 meter) increments per provincial guidelines. When Masses return to the church, please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

From Archbishop Gagnon- Your Kind Prayers:

Your kind prayers are requested for the repose of the soul of Reverend Michael K. Koryluk, a priest of the Archdiocese, who passed away in the early hours of the morning of August 8, a day shy of his 76th birthday.

Father Michael Koryluk was born in Winnipeg on August 9, 1944, the son and only child of the late Michael and Amy (nee Januszewski) Koryluk. Following graduation from the University of Manitoba, Fr Michael worked as a teacher for the Assiniboine South School Division for seven years. Discerning a call to the priesthood, Fr Michael attended Pope John XXIII Seminary in Weston, Massachusetts where he earned a Master of Divinity degree in 1979.

Father Michael was ordained to the Priesthood on April 25, 1979 at Holy Rosary Parish (Fr Mike's home parish) by Cardinal George Flahiff. From 1979-1983 Fr Michael served as the Parochial Vicar of St. Mary's Cathedral. Fr Michael served as Pastor of a number of Parishes in the Archdiocese including: St. Peter's Parish, Winnipeg (1983-1990), St. Mark's Mission, Winnipeg (1990-1995), St. John Brebeuf, Winnipeg (1995-2004) & as Rector of St. Mary's Cathedral (2004-2010). Fr Mike was appointed as Chaplain of St. Paul's College, where he served until his retirement in 2019.


Father Michael was involved in a number of councils and commissions of the Archdiocese including: the Council of Priests, the College of Consultors, the Liturgical Commission, the Archdiocesan choir and as the Dean in both the North and South Winnipeg deaneries. Fr Mike had a

love for music and was involved in the music for the Mass at Bird's Hill Park during the Papal visit of Pope John Paul II in 1984.

Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated Friday, August 14 at Holy Rosary Church.

May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.***
