

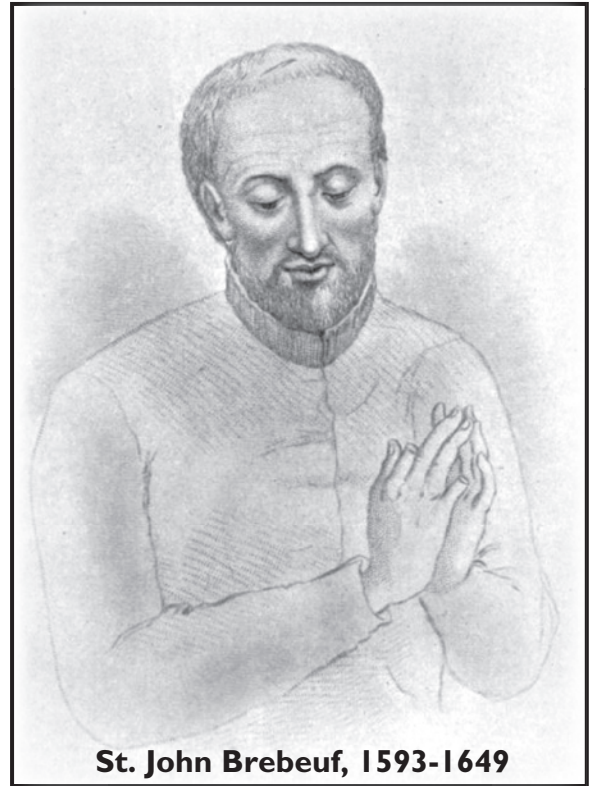

### Music Ministry:

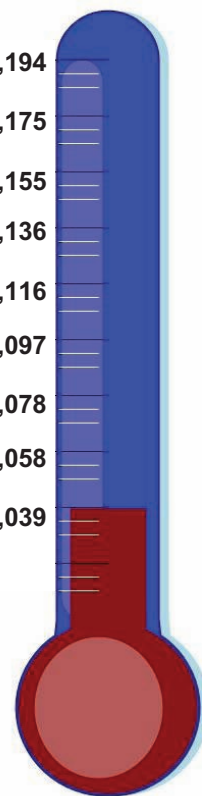
