



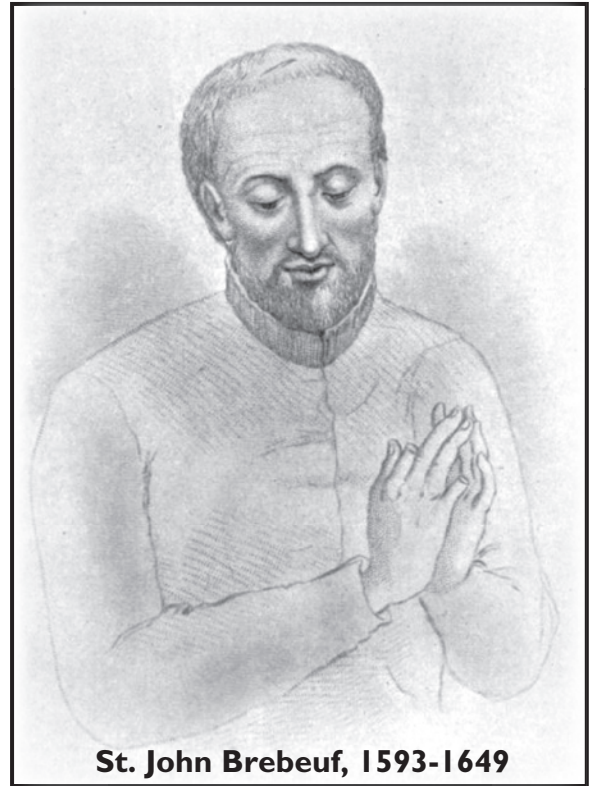

### **Masses Have Resumed in the Church:**

**Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only.** The door will be open 30 minutes prior to Masses.

Current **maximum capacity is 200** people.

Reservations are no longer required.

**Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.**

Please note that there is **no Morning Prayer or Rosary** at this time.

**Please sign in** (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

For Masses in the church, **please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews**. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** when you enter for Mass.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

- Runny nose
- Muscle aches
- Fatigue
- Conjunctivitis
- Headache
- Nausea or loss of appetite
- Skin rash of unknown origin
