

#### Attending In-Person Masses at St. John Brebeuf:

On August 3, the Provincial Government announced a further loosening of COVID-19 restrictions throughout Manitoba. Effective Saturday, August 7, 2021, Mass capacity at St. John Brebeuf is 325 people

Physical distancing and the use of facemasks are required for all indoor gatherings.

Reservations are no longer required for Masses.

Please note that restrictions are subject to change and all updates will be posted at www.sjbcommunity.ca

#### A Reminder of Mass Protocols:

**Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill**, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sign in when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please leave your offering in the designated basket at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please exit as soon as Mass ends without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well-being of all.


Your offering will be deducted from your bank account or credit card once per month. Forms and further information are available at **www.sjbcommunity.ca**.


