



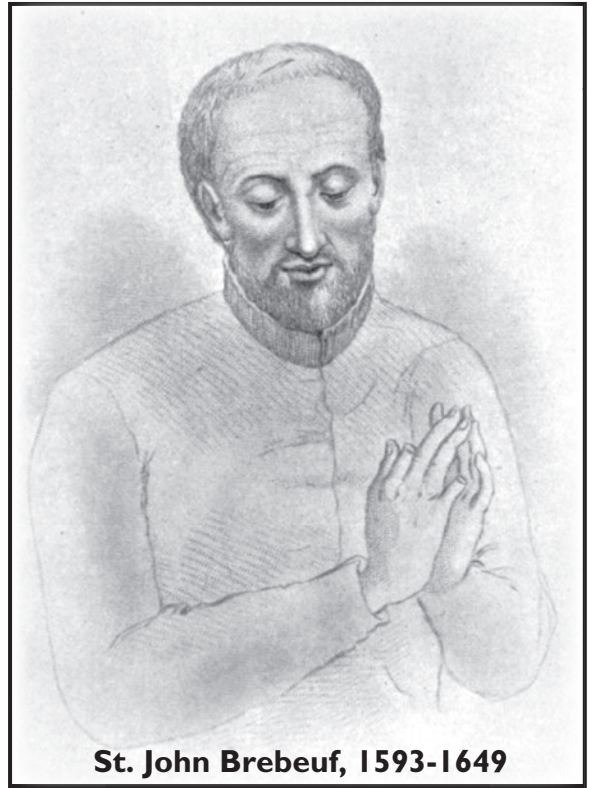

Attending In-Person Masses at St. John Brebeuf:

Reservations are not currently needed to attend Masses, with the exception of Christmas Masses (see below).

While in the church, Physical Distancing and the Use of Masks Is Required.

Please note that restrictions are subject to change and all updates will be posted at www.sjbcommunity.ca

A Reminder that all protocols are still in place!

Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **physical distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building. **The Use of Masks is required in the church.**

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well-being of all.

Parishioners may book seats for those living in their household. We appreciate your understanding as we try to accommodate as many parishioners as possible.

Our currently allowable capacity is 200 attendees.

All Mass attendance protocols, as listed above, including the requirement to wear masks while in the building, apply. All restrictions are subject to change, and we cannot exceed capacity.

Faith Formation:

Online registration for children's faith formation programs at St. John Brebeuf will be accepted until the end of 2021.

Children's Catechism: Offered as a Take-Home program, with resources provided by the parish. Parents are asked to pick up the resources in the church mailbox, and must pre-arrange the time/day with Claudia.

Sacrament of 1st Reconciliation/1st Eucharist: Celebrated in Grade 2. Parents prepare their children for these sacraments using resources provided by the parish.

Sacrament of Confirmation: Conferred in Gr. 8 for baptized children who are in full communion (receiving Eucharist) at St. John Brebeuf. A list of important dates is posted at www.sjbcommunity.ca.

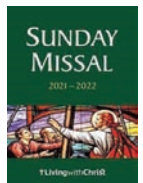
