

Our Target: \$57,320

Donations received to date: \$34,875

Each parish in the Archdiocese must contribute a designated amount to Sharing God's Gifts. If we have a shortfall in donations we must pay the balance from general revenues. In addition to the Sharing God's Gifts Assessment, our parish is also assessed annually for 16% of our collections.

For 2018, our Sharing God's Gifts obligation is \$57,320. To date, 62 of our families have contributed \$34,875 and pledged an additional \$3,250 for a total of \$38,125. We need the help of all parishioners to make up the shortfall of \$19,195. Please use the envelopes available at all church entrances to share your gifts. Thank you.
