



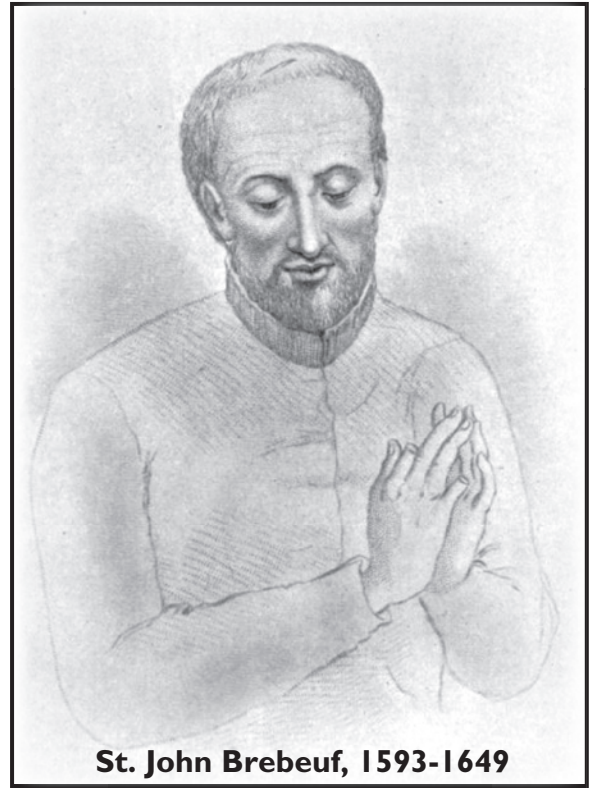

Masses Have Resumed in the Church:

Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 15 minutes prior to Masses.

Current **maximum capacity is 50** people.

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Weekday Masses: Attendees are required to sign in upon entry, including name and phone number. No reservations are required for weekday Masses, with the exception of Ash Wednesday.

Please note that there is **no Morning Prayer** at this time. Virtual Rosary will be offered Tuesdays and Thursdays at 10:30 am during Lent. More information to follow.

Multiple weekend Mass requests will not be accepted as we try to give as many people as possible the opportunity to attend Mass.

Please sign in (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

For Masses in the church, **please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews.** Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** when you enter for Mass.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

As of the time of bulletin publication, it is our understanding that the Parish Office will continue to remain closed to the public until further notice. Phone messages and e-mails will be returned as soon as possible. We will be closed Feb. 15 for Louis Riel Day.

From Father Wayne:

This past Tuesday we got the very good news that we can gather again for Mass, so our regular schedule of Eucharistic celebrations resumed on Friday at 9:15 a.m. Code Red rules remain in effect but we're very familiar with them by now even though we've been apart for so many weeks. Just a reminder of the main points:

- 1 Wearing a mask is necessary at Mass.
- 2 Maintaining a physical distance of at least six feet between people not of the same household is required.
- 3 Please stay home if you feel unwell for any reason.

We will be limited to no more than 50 people attending Mass for the foreseeable future. The practice of 'signing in' will continue in case contact tracing becomes necessary. (It hasn't been so far and I hope it never does.) Reserving a place at Mass will be needed for Saturdays, Sundays, and on Ash Wednesday.

I'm fairly sure we will have to live under restrictive health measures for some period of months; perhaps even into the summer and fall, but we know it's for the general good of all. I hope and pray rules don't have to become more restrictive again, as they have before, but we are prepared to do what must be done. For now, let's be happy that things are better now, and thank God for the blessings of today.
