Fast and Abstinence Guidelines:

Fasting: On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those aged 18 to 59 should only have one full meal. Two smaller meals, as needed, but eating solid foods between meals should be avoided.

Abstinence from Meat: Those who are 14 years or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fridays during Lent:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, 10am to Noon, followed by **Benediction.**

Stations of the Cross begins at 7pm

Copies of the **Lenten Reflection Books** for adults and children are available at the church entrances.

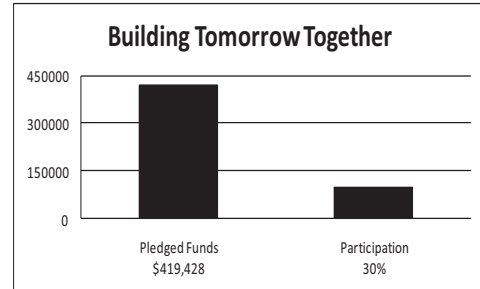
