

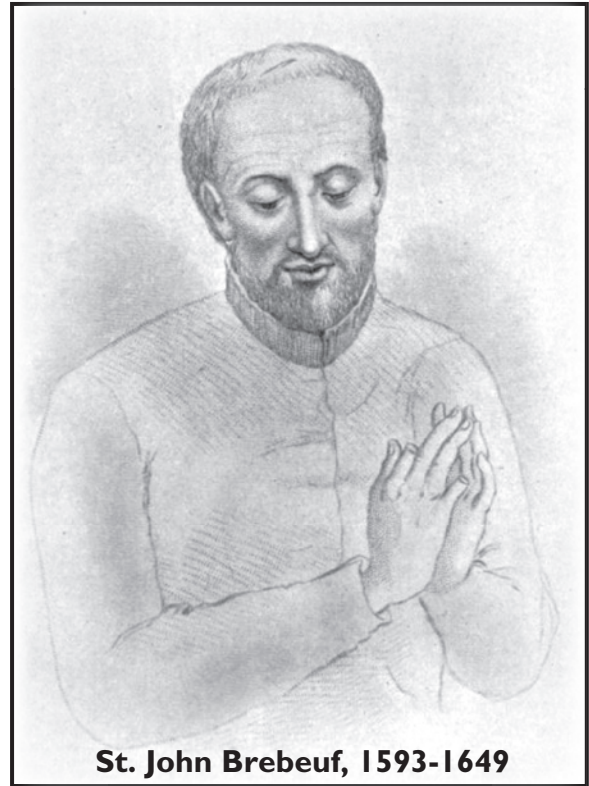

Film relives Mary's journey with the Cross

While attending Mass at St. Vital Catholic Church in Winnipeg in 2020, Bisong Taiwo's cinematic eye was entranced by the lighting of the Stations of the Cross sculptures hanging on the walls.

"I just thought, hey, it might be a nice idea to do a film about the Stations," said the 33-year-old Nigerian-born filmmaker based in Winnipeg. "I'm not exactly sure how it would come about, but that is what I wanted to do."

Continental Synthesis being written in Florida

The Universal Church - "The next step in the Continental Stage will take place in Florida this week. A small writing team will meet to produce a final Continental Synthesis to be submitted to the Secretariat for the Synod by March 31, 2023. Similar teams will meet on other continents to finalize their own documents, and each of these will feed into the working document called an "Instrumentum Laboris" (IL), which will form the basis for discussion during the Synod to be held in Rome in October 2023 and 2024. Our Archbishop Richard Gagnon is among the approximate 12-member team meetings in Florida. Let us pray for safe travels for His Grace, for the writing team's work, and that the Synod will lead to a resurgence of faith and spirit of evangelization in accordance with the intended direction of the Holy Spirit."
