For the month of February, we are collecting baby items for **Pregnancy & Family Support Services**.



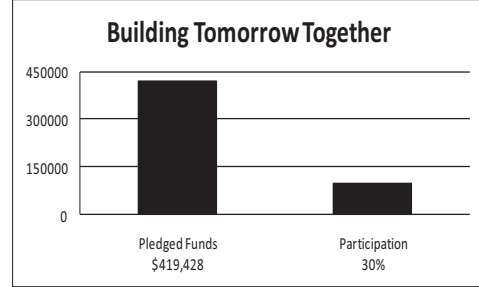
Most needed items include:
