Warm Socks for Cold Feet



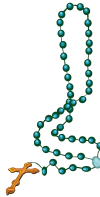

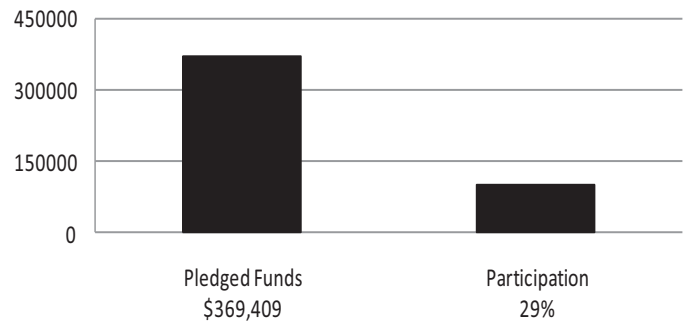
