

Reservations are required through the Parish Office for weekend Masses with a current capacity of 25 parishioners. Reservations are accepted weekdays until capacity is reached, or Friday at noon (whichever occurs first).


- Maintaining a Contact Database and the Archdiocesan Directory (online & print)

- Communicate plans & initiatives to implement the recommendations of the recently-concluded Archdiocesan Synod


