

## January 17/18, 2015: 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Second Sunday in OT: 1 Samuel 3:3-10, 19; 1 Cor 6:13-15, 17-20; John 1:35-42

A crack of sunlight flashed in Simon's face, rousing him from his afternoon reverie. He had been lying motionless in bed staring at the empty peg on the wall where his wife's cloak had hung earlier. She had set out that morning for her mother's place; she left without saying a word. Simon, however, had said many things as she was walking out the door. He had hurled all manner of insults and accusations at her in a fit of rage. Even now in silence and calm, he seethed at the brightness that dared intrude on his moping.
