

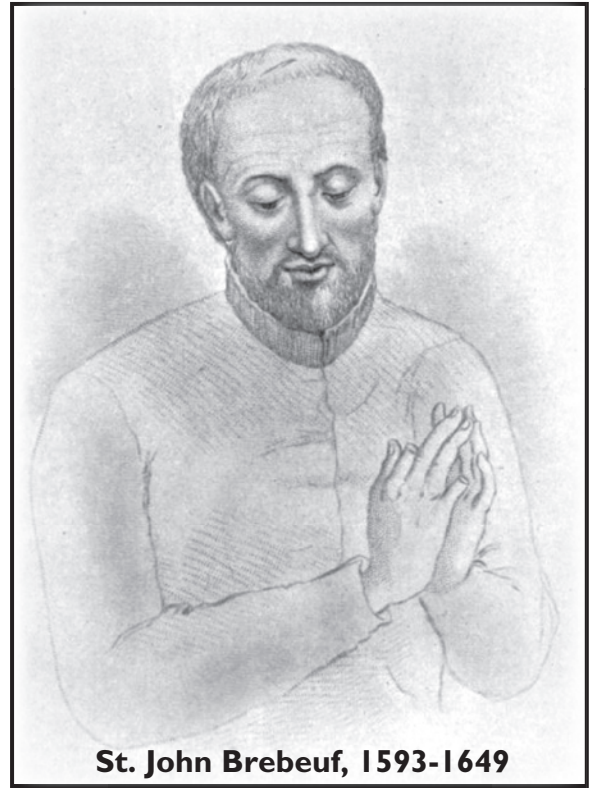

In the context of praying together for Christian unity, the 2023 theme, **“Do good; seek justice”** (Isaiah 1:17), invites us to reflect on what unites us and to commit ourselves to confront oppression and division amongst humanity. God expects us as Christians to unite in a shared responsibility for equity for all God's children as we bring the Good News of God's love in Christ to a broken world in need of healing.

The 2023 Week of Prayer will be marked by a City-wide Ecumenical Worship Service at 7:30 pm on Sunday, January 22, 2023, at Saint John XXIII Roman Catholic Church, 3390 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg. 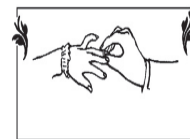
