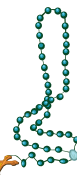

Please drop off donations in the Playpen at the main church entrance.

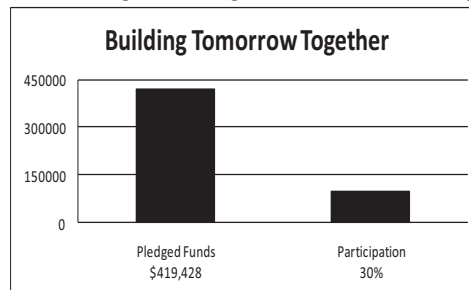
## Knights of Columbus #1107
