



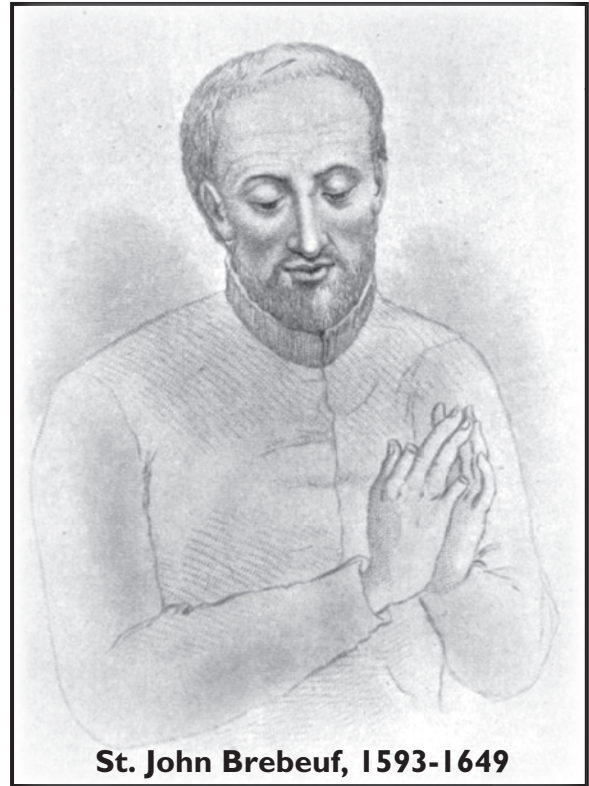

### Attending In-Person Masses at St. John Brebeuf:

**Reservations are required through the Parish Office for weekend Masses with a current capacity of 25 parishioners.** Reservations are accepted weekdays until capacity is reached, or until Friday's at noon (whichever occurs first). The office is not open on weekends to accept reservations.

### While in the church, Physical Distancing and the Use of Masks Is Required.

### A Reminder that all protocols are still in place!

**Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill**, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **physical distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building. **The Use of Masks is required in the church.**

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

**Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews.** Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well-being of all.
