

From Father Wayne:

Two years ago I visited Manaus, a city far up the Amazon River in Brazil. Typical of the Amazon basin, Manaus is a poor city lacking fresh water for many people and infrastructure that other parts of Brazil take for granted. The people in the city and around it seemed happy in spite of it all. Since then they have been hit very hard by Covid 19. I hate to think of what must have happened to the people I met. This time is so hard for us, but we have to give a thought and a prayer for other people who have it even worse. They are far away and close by. The need to care in ways that make a difference always remains.



Continuation of Code Red:

Per the extended Provincial Code Red Order, all public services at St. John Brebeuf Parish continue to be cancelled until further notice.

The most recent public health orders for the Province of Manitoba which took effect at 12:01am on Saturday, January 23, 2021, increase the number of persons allowed to be at funerals to ten (10) people. This does not include the presider, one (1) cantor, one (1) accompanist, and funeral home staff. Celebrations of weddings and baptisms remain restricted to five (5) people.


