
**Winnipeg Harvest**: Until there is no longer a need for food banks in our community, we will continue to collect non-perishable food items for Winnipeg Harvest.

This is our feast. This is the celebration of Jesus made manifest to the Gentiles as represented by the three magi. It shows



that the Gentiles are coheirs with the Jews in God's promises. The date of the Epiphany of Our Lord used to be January 6th, but it was moved to the first Sunday after January first. In many countries this is the day on which gifts are exchanged, remembering the gifts given by the magi.
