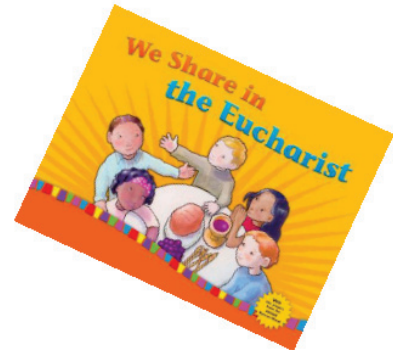


## Grade 2 Sacraments of First Reconciliation / First Eucharist
