Now that Masses have resumed...

Due to church construction **all Masses will be celebrated in the St. John Brebeuf School Gym* until further notice. Entry will be via the 605 Renfrew Street door only**, which opens 15 minutes prior to Masses. (*Subject to change when construction complete)

Per the provincial order, we are currently limited to **50 people in the building.**

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Weekday Masses: Attendees are required to sign in upon entry, including name and phone number. No reservations are required for weekday Masses. Please note that there is no Morning Prayer or Rosary at this time.

Weekend Masses: To attend Saturday 5pm and Sunday 10am Masses, reservations are required through the Parish Office. **Email Claudia at cmoreta@sjbcommunity.ca or call 204-488-4467 (Ext. 217)** to submit your request, leaving your name, phone number, and the names of those in your family who wish to attend. You will be contacted before the weekend to confirm availability. Multiple weekend requests will not be accepted, as we try to give as many people as possible the opportunity to attend Mass. Those wishing to try in person on the weekend for a walk-up spot may do so, understanding that we cannot exceed the 50 person capacity. Please see the Knights of Columbus greeter to check off your name(s) or inquire about availability upon arrival at Mass.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** when you enter for Mass.

For Masses in the gym, seating is spaced in six foot (2 meter) increments per provincial guidelines. When Masses return to the church, please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

While we are limited for Mass capacity, and for those who will be spending more time at the cottage...
