



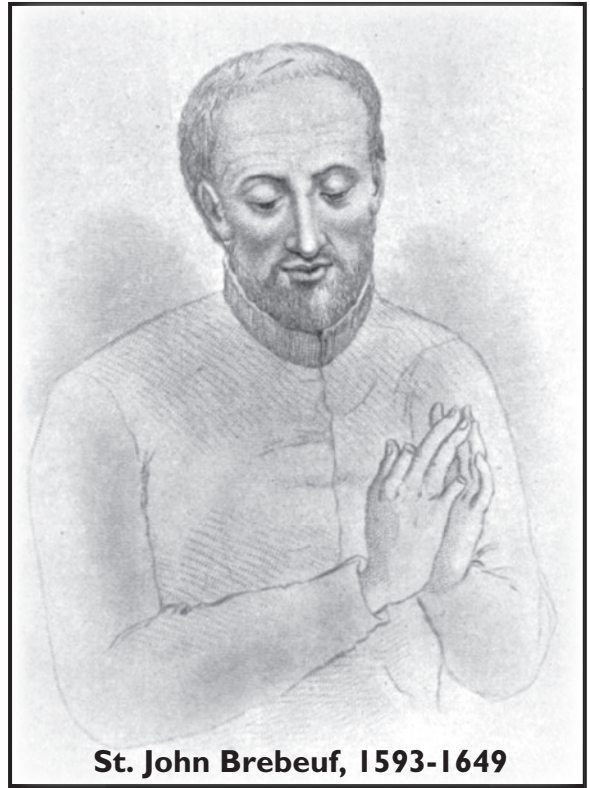

### Did You Know....

...that a pledge can be as great (or greater?) than a Donation.

Think about it for a minute from the perspective of stewardship.

If according to Deuteronomy 26, we are supposed to give of our "first fruits", that would imply that we are to give first and live off the rest. Contrast this with those who live first and give what is left over. While all gifts are treasured by the Annual Appeal, there is something profoundly faithful about someone willing to make a commitment now for a payment they must make in an uncertain future. 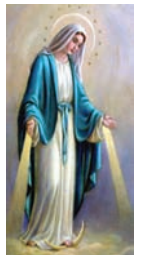
