

Dear Community Members,

As many of you know, our community is dedicated to assisting refugees by providing them with support through our Refugee Fund. Unfortunately, we at SJB parish are not permitted to sponsor Ukrainian refugees directly. But we can help other places that do. We have started working with the Ukrainian Catholic Church here in Manitoba to bolster their efforts for those fleeing conflict in the Ukraine. Recently, the Chancellor of the Archeparchy of Winnipeg suggested we make a donation of \$5,000 from our refugee fund to their summer camp program for Ukrainian refugee children. We are happy to do so and have a number of other initiatives on the list he gave us. More about this soon.


