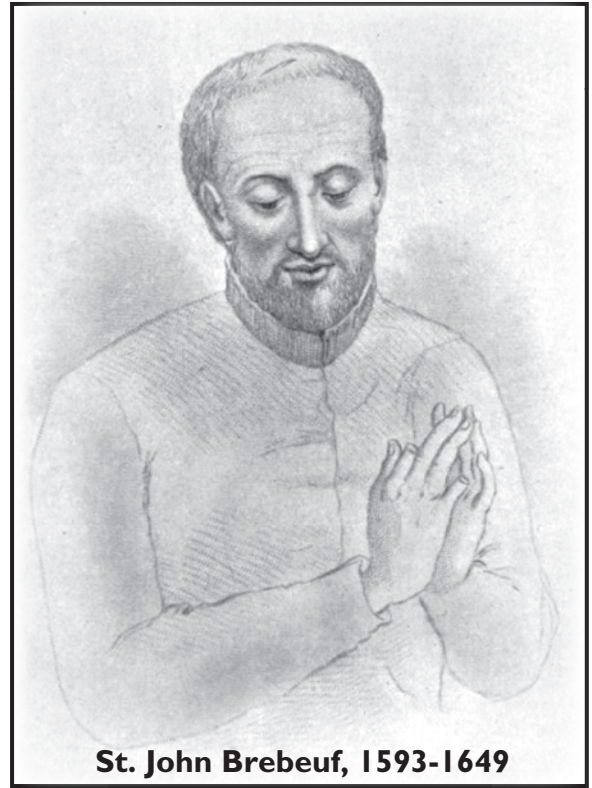

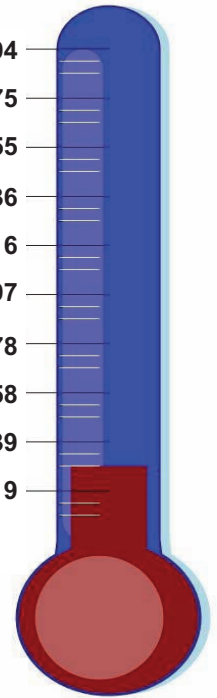
Music Ministry:
