


Suspension of Faith Gatherings:

As announced on May 27 by the Provincial Government, all Faith Gatherings, including in-person Masses, continue to be suspended. The celebrations of weddings, funerals and baptisms are permitted, with a maximum of ten (10) attendees. The restrictions will be in place until at least June 26, 2021*. (*Subject to change)

The Parish Office remains closed to the public. All messages are returned as soon as possible.

From Father Wayne:

The virus has deprived us of so many community celebrations over the last fifteen months. This time it's Fathers' Day. We can't gather to celebrate fathers as we would like to, but there can be small, family celebrations of fatherhood. They are very important and will remind us of what is most wonderful about fathers, without forgetting the many fathers who are kept apart from us by distance and isolation. Knowing the long ordeal of the pandemic is coming to an end lifts many spirits these day. We hope and pray the end is in sight. Phased reopening is to start on July 1 and St. John Brebeuf will be ready to go right away. It's clear we won't be at full capacity in the beginning. It might be a while before some familiar things like communion from the cup and shaking hands come back. But we can do what we have to do to be happy, safe and well. BASEMENT RENOVATIONS & RESTORATION PROJECT PROJECT UPDATE

June 2021

St. John Brebeuf Parish and School are set to embark upon renovation and restoration activities over the next number of months. This communique is to provide parishioners with a background to the project along with a project status update.

Background

Over the past number of years, the Parish and School have been in discussion regarding proposed renovations that would provide for much needed upgrades to various areas in the Church Basement that are utilized by the Parish and the School. The specific areas in question requiring renovations and upgrades include the Kitchen/ Servery, Basement Washrooms and the Music Room that is adjacent to the Kitchen/ Servery.

In July 2020, the Parish experienced a water event at the Basement level caused by rupture of an original water pipe that resulted in flooding and significant damage to the Kitchen/Servery, existing Music Room, Basement Washrooms, Offices along the Basement corridor as well as the corridor itself. Since the restoration of the affected areas became the subject of an insurance claim; the Parish and School elected to integrate the proposed renovations and upgrades to the Kitchen/Servery, Main Washrooms and Music Room into an overall project. The capital cost of the project is estimated at approximately \$450K and will be partially offset by the insurance claim amount and is being cost-shared between the Parish and the School.

Project Status

In the Fall of 2020, a project Working Group was formed, that included representation from the Parish and the School, and focussed upon the specific needs, details, scheduling and internal management of the project. In the Winter of 2020, a Design Consultant was commissioned towards the development of design and tender documents that would form the basis of the renovations and restoration. In the Spring of 2021, a Construction Manager was engaged to assist in the development of capital cost budgets, proposed construction scheduling and constructibility reviews. Once an approved project budget was confirmed, the Construction Manager would assume the role of the General Contractor and be responsible for the overall renovations and restoration project.

In June 2021, and based upon a formal submission to the Archdiocese of Winnipeg, SJB received approval to proceed with the project. Accordingly, the General Contractor is currently mobilizing and demolition and renovations are set to begin within the next week. The project schedule indicates the work should be completed in approximately 3 months targeting the Fall of 2021 as re-opening of the Church Basement area.


