

Now that Masses have resumed...

Entry and exit for all Masses June 20 and 21 is via the John Brebeuf Place entrance only. The door will be open 15 minutes prior to Masses.

Important Note: Due to church construction commencing June 22, all Masses will be celebrated from June 23 until further notice in the St. John Brebeuf School Gym. Entry will be via the 605 Renfrew Street door.

Per the provincial order, we are limited to **25 people in the building until June 20**, then **a maximum of 50 as of June 21**.

Weekday Masses: Attendees are required to sign in upon entry, including name and phone number. No reservations are required for weekday Masses. Please note that there is no Morning Prayer or Rosary at this time.

Weekend Masses: To attend Saturday 5pm and Sunday 10am Masses, reservations are required through the Parish Office.

Email parishoffice@sjbcommunity.ca or call 204-488-4467 (Ext. 210) to submit your request, leaving your name, phone number, and the names of those in your family who wish to attend. You will be contacted before the weekend to confirm availability. Multiple weekend requests will not be accepted, as we try to give as many people as possible the opportunity to attend Mass. Please see the Knights of Columbus greeter to check off your name(s) upon arrival at Mass.

Please sanitize your hands as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

For Masses in the church, please **limit seating to designated 'angel' pews**. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required. Seating will be appropriately spaced when Masses move to the school gym.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at when you enter for Mass.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

City of Winnipeg Construction Notices (vicinity of St. John Brebeuf Church):

1) Lanark Street from Corydon Avenue to John Brebeuf Place

Starting June 15, 2020 for approximately six weeks to complete, weather permitting:

Construction is expected to commence Monday, June 15 on a street renewal project affecting Lanark Street from Corydon Ave. to John Brebeuf Place. As the City of Winnipeg will be fully reconstructing the street, curb, sidewalks and private approaches, Lanark St. will be fully closed to through traffic. Street parking will be prohibited and parishioners will be asked to access the church parking lot via the back lane entrance (off Renfrew St.). Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Given that this is a time of much uncertainty, the City of Winnipeg wants to assure area residents and parishioners of St. John Brebeuf Church that they are proceeding on the assumption that construction season will continue amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Additionally, as the health and safety of both the public and construction staff and contractors is paramount, they will be modifying their work plan as required, as per Manitoba Health recommendations for the industry.

2) City of Winnipeg Sidewalk Renewal

John Brebeuf Place from Beaverbrook Street to Lanark Street (North Side) Commencement Date: Week of June 18, 2020, weather permitting Duration: Approximately two to three weeks, weather permitting

The City of Winnipeg wishes to advise that a sidewalk renewal project on John Brebeuf Place from Beaverbrook St. to Lanark Street (north side) has been approved for construction as part of the City of Winnipeg's 2020 Local Sidewalk Renewal Program.

The contractor responsible for the sidewalk construction is J.C. Paving Ltd. During construction, on-street parking will be prohibited and the curb lane will be barricaded at times. Pedestrian access to all businesses and residential premises will be maintained, including St. John Brebeuf Church.

The work will include full renewal of the existing concrete sidewalks, renewal of concrete curbs where required, and landscaping of the boulevard and private property as required.

The road will be open to local traffic at all times and will be signed to advise motorists of the construction ahead.

The City of Winnipeg recognizes that these projects will cause some inconvenience and disruption and they thank you for your understanding and patience during construction.
