Zechariah 9.9-10 *Lo, your king comes to you, humble and riding on a donkey.* A prophet describes the arrival of a new king who brings peace to the world.

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 145.1-2,8-9,10-11,13cd-14
R. *I will bless your name for ever, my King and my God.*

Romans 8.9, 11-13 *If by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.* Paul reminds us that we are not "in the flesh". Flesh refers to self-indulgence. With the Spirit's help, we can conquer evil and live for God.

Matthew 11.25-30 *I am gentle and humble in heart.* Jesus thanks the Father for granting the gift of revelation to his childlike disciples and hiding it from the so-called wise and intelligent religious leaders of his day.

THE NEW TRANSLATION - WHAT NEW TRANSLATION?

Did you know that the translation of the Mass which we currently use is going to change? The texts we have now have been in use since 1970 and on the First Sunday of Advent we will begin to use a new translation. Over the coming weeks/months there will be short articles in the bulletin which will help us to understand what these changes are and why they have come about. There will also be plenty of opportunities provided to learn more about it and become familiar with the changes. A number of day and evening sessions will be arranged for those who would like to find out more. We will publish some material ourselves and will also provide web links for those who have Internet access. This will be a great opportunity for us all to learn more about the Mass and deepen our understanding of the liturgy and its meaning and relevance for us in our lives today. Watch this space!

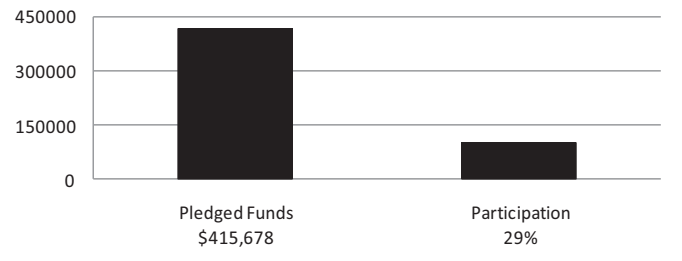
