



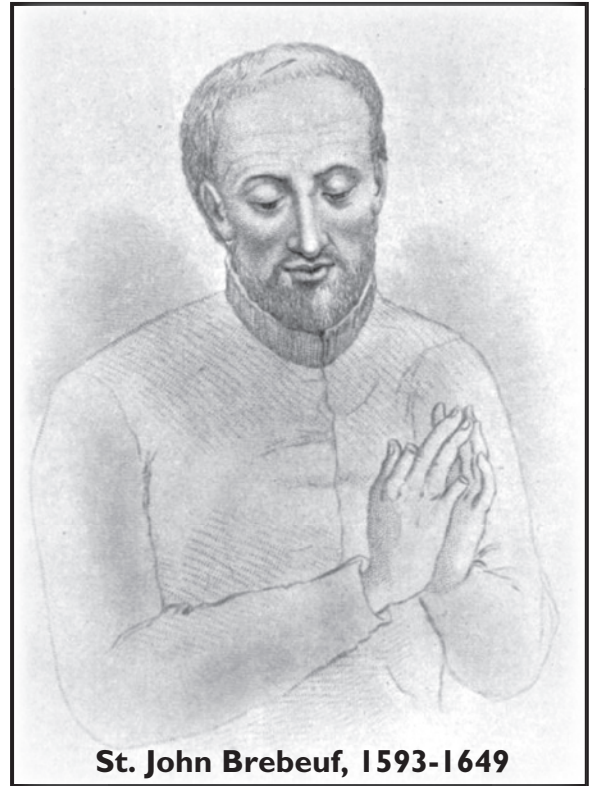

### Resumption of In-Person Masses:

As of Saturday, June 26, **in-person Masses, can resume with a maximum capacity of twenty-five (25).**

**Reservations are required for weekend Masses.** They are accepted starting on Monday's until capacity is reached: parishoffice@sjbcommunity.ca or 204-488-4467 (Ext. 210). We will not accept bookings beyond the current week. **No entry without reservation please.**

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to work within limitations to accommodate as many parishioners as possible who wish to attend.

The Celebration of weddings, funerals and baptisms is permitted, with a maximum capacity of ten (10) attendees.

### A Reminder of Mass Protocols:

**Do not come to Mass if you are feeling ill,** particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

**Please sign in (weekdays) or check in with the door greeter weekends** when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please **leave your offering in the designated basket** at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

**Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews.** Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please **exit as soon as Mass ends** without pausing inside to chat.

**The Parish Office remains closed to the public.** All messages are returned as soon as possible. If we do not have your current contact information, please email or call so that we can update our parish records.

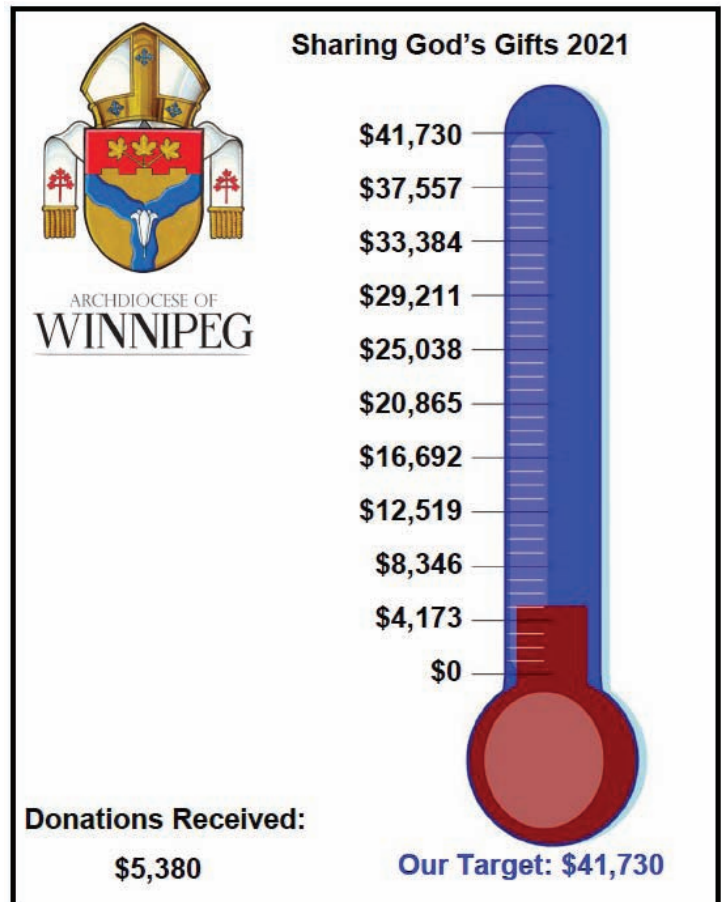
