March 1 Update to COVID-19 Restrictions:

Effective March 1, **there are no longer any capacity restrictions** throughout Manitoba, including Places of Worship and Sunday Mass. **The protocols on wearing masks in indoor places continue until March 15.**



The general dispensation from Sunday Mass will not be renewed at this time. Keeping contact lists will no longer be required. For the comfort of all, attendees should self-screen before arriving at Mass for any symptoms of COVID-19. If people are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, they should refrain from coming to Mass.

Please note the following updates to Liturgical Protocols:

1. Weekday and Sunday Masses can return to normal with **no capacity restrictions**. **Masks must still be worn indoors** for Masses and any meetings or gatherings within our building.
2. Parishes are encouraged to continue **live-streaming** of Mass to benefit members of the community who are shut-in or in personal care homes. St. John Brebeuf will continue to live-stream our Sunday 10am Mass via the parish website: www.sjbcommunity.ca
3. **Hand sanitizing** stations will remain in place.
4. **Collection Procedures** may resume to pre-pandemic practice.
5. **Offertory Processions** can be re-instated to pre-pandemic practice.
6. **Celebrations of First Communions, Baptisms, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Marriages and Funerals** return to normal with no capacity restrictions. Masks must still be worn indoors.
7. **Celebration of Confirmation** can be celebrated with no capacity restrictions. The Archbishop will resume celebrating Confirmation in parishes after the celebration of Easter.
8. The **Sign of Peace** will continue to be expressed with a head bow toward others in the assembly.
9. **Communion Processions** can return without physical distancing.
10. **The Distribution of Communion** returns to pre-pandemic practice with the exception that the communion cup will not be offered and receiving Communion on the hand will be the general practice.
11. **Holy Water** fonts may be filled and used.

The bishops of Manitoba will be meeting in the coming weeks to discuss further developments, and additional announcements will follow.

Madagascar: an ecological village to cope with climate change



Development and Peace's *People and Planet First* campaign celebrates what solidarity can achieve, even against seemingly impossible odds.

In Madagascar, for instance, Development and Peace's partner, the Development Council of Andohatapenaka (CDA), empowers people to manage and transform their neighbourhoods.

In the capital region, which is afflicted by flooding and poor waste management, CDA has helped the residents of one vulnerable area to turn their environs into a thriving ecological village. Today, each of the 50 households involved in the project has a vegetable garden, a stove and solar panels. This transformation reflects a true ecological conversion.
