


Children: Preparation for First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation is provided through our Parish Community. Information is available through the parish office, on line or in the bulletin.

In-Person Masses Have Resumed in the Church:

Entry and exit for all Masses via John Brebeuf Place only. The door will be open 15 minutes prior to Masses.

Current maximum capacity is 100 people. Reservations are no longer required, with the exception of Holy Week Masses. These must be reserved through the Parish Office.

Do not come to Mass or visit the Parish Office if you are feeling ill, particularly if you are experiencing a cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.

Please sign in with your name and phone number (preferably with your own pen) when you enter the church.

Please **sanitize your hands** as you enter for Mass.

Please maintain **social distancing of six feet** (2 meters) between people while in the building.

Please leave your offering in the designated basket at the main church aisle when you enter the worship space.

Please limit seating to designated 'angel' pews. Unless you have come as a family unit, individual distancing of six feet (2 meters) within pews is required.

Once you have selected seating, please remain in your seat, except for the receipt of Communion. Parents, please keep your children with you.

Please exit as soon as Mass ends without pausing inside to chat.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate the changing rules and regulations in place for the safety and well being of all.

The Parish Office will continue to remain closed to the public until further notice. Phone messages and e-mails will be returned as soon as possible.
